

ADMISSION 2014

It is very important to remember your **Class Teacher Group (CT Group)**. The teacher who teaches you the subject of your CT Group is your **Class Teacher**.

The CT Group is written as Grade and one of your classes which is specified by the school. **For example**, the CT Group of a student who has been given the following combination of subjects is “11 CHEM Y” (not “11 BIOL X” or “11 PHYS Z”).
